<b>Purple Rain</b> — <b>New this year!</b> A very unusual color for amaryllis. Fuchsia-pink etched upper petals and paler-pink etched lower petals with a dark fuchsia-merlot star and striking fuchsia-pink anthers. <b><u>\$18 each for this unusual new introduction</u></b>		
<b>Temptation</b> —Very vibrant and showy. White with diffuse raspberry to crimson splashes on its upper petals. Also a dark scarlet-red starburst and pink to white stamens.

<b>Iris tuberosum—Hermodactylus</b> —One of Hortense’s favorite bulbs. It is named after Hermes, the god of thieves, who had very long and supple fingers—just like the leaves of this bulb. 6 bulbs for \$4.00		
<b>Iris Rosario</b> —always popular, it has violet standards with a pink flush. A reliable Dutch iris. 6 bulbs for \$2.00		
<b>Narcissus Golden Dawn</b> —It is hard to find a narcissus that will come back each year in our area. Yellow with a bright orange cup in the center. 6 bulbs for \$5.00
